	Epidemic of communicable disease reported	<p><b>One suspected case of H1N1 reported at Jagdalpur. Blood sample was taken and sent to NICD, Delhi for investigation and confirmation. NICD, Delhi confirmed that report was negative.</b></p> <p>17 death case reported due to sudden acute fever at Chhattisgarh Institute of Medical Science (CIMS), Bilaspur during the period. All the affected children have died within 45 minutes to 7 hours in the age group 3-18 years. The samples were collected and sent to NICD and NVBDCP, New Delhi for investigation. It was informed that the deaths were not due to JE.</p> <p>On 2 July 2009, outbreak of the Diarrhoea cases at Jalke village (CHC - Podiupada) Korba district (total population of the village is 3200, located in 13 different hamlets). In one hamlet out of 159 population 72 were suffered from the episode of diarrhoea and 4 deaths were reported upto 8/7/09. The District epidemic team and State authority conducted the investigation and steps were taken to reduce morbidity and mortality and further spread of infection. Micrio-biology department, Govt. Medical College, Raipur confirmed that <b>3 cases are having V-Cholera.</b></p>
