1	<p data-bbox="329 338 643 369"><b>Liaison &amp; Coordination:</b></p> <p data-bbox="378 373 1490 548">(i) The Director of Health Services, Chhattisgarh has been requested to provide information regarding Private Sector Allopathic Medical and Health Care Institutions and Beds in Rural and Urban Areas in the State as desired by Central Bureau of Health Intelligence, Directorate General of Health Services, New Delhi.</p> <p data-bbox="378 558 1490 806">(ii) The Director of Health Services, Chhattisgarh has been sensitized about the concern of Deputy Director General (TB) regarding 31% cure rate in the State, vacant posts of key personnel in the State/Districts and requested to STO/DTO to take immediate action to fill all the vacant posts by the end of March 2011, he has also requested to take all efforts to provide patient's friendly DOTS at all the centres and the factual status should be reported for successful implementation of TB control program.</p> <p data-bbox="378 816 1490 1136">(iii) State Program Officer (Malaria) has been informed about the decision of NVBDCP, Delhi that the monthly reports is to be submitted in the M4 format only and the existing MES is to be discontinued with effect from January 2011 onwards and this format will be used for reporting from all level starting from the sub-center to PHC, District and State and will be compiled at next higher level. The format M4 has to be operationalized in all health facilities like PHC, Sub-Centers and ASHAs. For reporting of IRS and LLIN/ITN the format to be used are available as VC2 and VC4 respectively.
