I.	<p>Liaison & Coordination:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. As per the guidelines received from National Program for control of Blindness, New Delhi, 25th National Fortnight on Eye donation is to be observed during the period from 25 August to 8 September 2010 under National Program for control of blindness, State Health Authorities has been sensitized about the above mentioned program and have requested for comprehensive approach by involving more and more NHPs, Resident Welfare Association, Religious leaders, Schools, colleges, Universities, Medical Colleges, Nursing Colleges, Anganwadi Workers and volunteers to have the maximum potential exploration. 2. As per the direction received from Directorate of NVBDCP, Delhi SPO has been requested to take immediate action for filling up the vacant post of Consultants in the States and district under the World Bank Project in collaboration with NRHM as NVBDCP HQ has already decentralized the recruitment of supporting staff to State/District Health Societies under the WB Project. 3. As directed by the NVBDCP HQ, requested State Health Authorities to provide the information regarding available training facilities in the State to impart training to contractual MPWs for three months, which could be HFWTC, RTC, ANM TC, GNM TC, DTC, MPW (M) TC etc. 4. SPO Malaria has been intimated about the concern of NVBDCP HQ regarding excess stock of Chloroquine Tab., Primaquine Tab. And Arteether Injection and have also intimated them that State itself is responsible for the distribution of excess stock lying at State Drug Store and DMCs to its PHCs/Districts, so that drugs can be utilized within their shelf life. 5. SPO Malaria has been conveyed the decision of NVBDCP, Delhi regarding acceptance of Pt. J.N.M. College, Raipur and Sardar Vallabh Bhai Patel District Hospital, Bilaspur for diagnosis and treatment of Dengue fever cases. 6. As directed by the NVBDCP HQ, requested SPO Malaria to send mosquito blood meal samples of vector mosquitoes from different parts of the state in order to monitor the disease transmission and feeding preferences of vector.

Medical College students of pre-final year were imparted one day brief training in clinical and epidemiological aspects of leprosy. 2. 4 students of BPT, Pt. J.N.M. Medical College, Raipur & 3 students of BPT, Physiotherapy College attended one week internship training during the month of July 2010.
III.	<p>Other Technical Activities: 3 officers of this Institute namely Dr. R.N. Sabat, Dr. A.K. Misra and Dr. M.K. Soni visited Haryana, Himachal Pradesh and Manipur in connection with National Sample Survey</p>

(Ortho) met with SLO, Chhattisgarh to clear the backlog of RCS and have also visited 8 districts of Chhattisgarh namely District Raipur, Korba, Raigarh, Janjgir, Rajnandgaon, Kabirdham, Durg & Mahasamund with the team of Central Leprosy Division, DGHS, New Delhi led by Dr. Anoop Puri, DADG (Leprosy). 2. We are regularly coordinating with State Health Authorities to improve the Health Management Information System (HMIS) in the State and are conducting meeting every month with State HMIS officials to look after the various set-backs found in the system and try to remove the obstacles by discussing with the State and District authorities during the meeting.
