1.	<p>Liaison & Coordination:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ As intimated by NVBDCP, Delhi, State Program Officer, Malaria has been requested to attend meeting at NVBDCP, Delhi on 20.09.2010, with the relevant information/data regarding Malaria and progress on recruitment of consultants, training, M & E, gaps and challenges etc. in respect of the state for discussion. ✓ One officer of this Institute attended a meeting organized by Directorate of Health Services, Chhattisgarh to discuss implementation of Mass Drug Administration of Filaria Control Program 2010. ✓ As per the information received from Central Bureau of Health Intelligence, New Delhi, State Nodal Officer, SBHI has been requested to furnish online monthly reports on Communicable and Non-Communicable Disease to National HQ CBHI. ✓ As intimated by Adviser (Nutrition), Directorate General of Health Services, New Delhi, invitation to the Director of Health Services, Chhattisgarh has been extended to attend two day policy level "National Multi Sectoral Workshop on National Iodine Deficiency Disorders Control Program (NIDDCP) scheduled to be held on 21-22 October 2010 at Vigyan Bhavan Annexe, New Delhi. ✓ As per the direction received from Adviser (Nutrition), Directorate General of Health Services, State Nodal Officer (IDD) has been requested to provide the feedback of the usage of the Salt Testing Kits in all the districts and results of the same and also requested the State Authorities to fill up the posts of Technical Officer (IDD), Statistical Assistant, one LDC/DEO, 1 Lab. Tech. and 1 Lab. Asstt. Specifically for IDD monitoring and to utilize the funds allocation made to the state.
2.	<p>Training:</p> <p>We have sent a proposal to Central Leprosy Division, DGHS, New Delhi to conduct 4 batches of District Leprosy Officer Training for a period of one week duration (5 working days), which is likely to commence in the month of November 2010. Each batch consists of 25 trainees.</p>
3.	<p>Other Technical Activities:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. HMIS Technical Supervision report for the district Mahasamund is enclosed 2. RCS camp (Leprosy) has been organized at Korba district in which 9 patients were operated (10 procedures)
4.	<p>Administration Activities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ The Director of the Institute has been included as one of the member of the selection committee for selection of various posts under State Leprosy Society, Chhattisgarh. ✓ WE have been informed by one leprosy patient belongs to District Durg that although he was getting treatment from PHC near to his home but he was not registered there, whereas the patient was referred from this Institute after confirm diagnosis as a case of leprosy for further treatment. The matter has been brought to the notice of the Chief Medical and Health Officer, Durg district.

5.	<p>Institutions Visited and Reviewed:</p> <p>As per the inputs received from various patients regarding non-receipt of timely treatment and MDT drugs for the treatment of Leprosy from Bhatagaon PHC (Raipur District), a team led by Dr. Gitte visited the concerned health facility on 08.09.2010 and found that the matter reported by various patients is true.</p> <p>Out of the 90 confirmed cases of leprosy (in last 18 months) referred from this Institute to the Bhatagaon PHC for registration and treatment, 28 leprosy patients remain unregistered and may not get further treatment.</p> <p>The matter has been brought to the notice of the Secretary (Health), Government of Chhattisgarh.</p>
6.	<p>Cross verification /Field verification:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ The blood slides collected from Dongargaon CHC during the district visit has been cross checked and we have observed that out of 6 positive blood slides collected, 3 slides were found negative, the results of the 6 negative blood slides were found correct. The matter has been reported to the District Malaria Officer, Rajnandgaon. ✓ 202 blood slides collected from District Mahasamund has been cross checked and not found any discrepancy. Out of the 202 slides, 18 positive slides were cross checked and found correct and no discrepancy noted.
7.	<p>Review of NVBDCP:</p> <p>Detailed report of Mahasamund district in the prescribed format is enclosed.</p> <p>From Jan 2010 to Aug 2010, 106154 blood slides collected from 5 blocks of the district of which 86646 were examined for malaria, of which 310 were positive. 194 having diagnosed as p falciparum malaria and 306 were given radical treatment. Pf percentage is 62.6% and API was 0.275. In field surveyed area, the diagnosis is available within 24 hours of the collection. In surveyed four blocks large number of the slide backlog for blood slide examination due to vacant post of the lab technicians. The malaria related reporting was not updated in the surveyed health facilities.</p>
