As per the news published in print media, deaths reported due to malaria in Bilaspur, Rajnandgaon, Bastar, Dantewada, Jashpur, Koriya, Sarguja, Kanker district of Chhattisgarh. We have requested State Program Officer, Malaria to immediately investigate the matter and send detailed report to the National HQ.2. As advised by NVBDCP, Delhi, State Program Officer has been requested to ensure that the concerned officer of the district/Consultant monitor and visit the high endemic areas on regular basis and their visit report should reach NVBDCP HQ regularly. The observation and suggestion made during the visits may also be intimated to the NVBDCP HQ.3. As per the information received from NVBDCP, the State Program Officer, Malaria has been requested to implement the observations and suggestion of the Audit report for optimum utilization of supplied materials as well as to bring transparency in allotment of material to PHC as well as appropriate maintenance of Stock Registers and other peripherals.4. As desired by EMR Division of the Directorate General of Health Services, New Delhi, requested State Nodal Officer, Swine Flu to inform the utilization status of H₁N₁ vaccine supplied by the Directorate General of Health Services, New Delhi. The information supplied by the State Nodal Officer has been immediately forwarded to EMR Division, Directorate General of Health Services, New Delhi.5. As per the information received from NVBDCP, Delhi, State Program Officer has been requested to participate in the discussion/deliberation on Action Plan 2011-2012 organized by NVBDCP HQ, New Delhi on 12 & 13 November 2010.6. The Deputy Director General and Director, CBHI vide his letter dated 13.10.2010 has requested to provide the number of Allopathic doctors (general/specialist) and dental surgeons in different categories of private sector medical/health care institution as on 31.12.2009 in the State, accordingly we have requested State Health Authorities to expedite the information.7. As desired by NVBDCP, Delhi we have informed State Program Officer, Malaria has been informed that NVBDCP is an integrated program and being implemented through primary health care system throughout the country. Under multipurpose health scheme all health workers as well as Laboratory technicians available under various health programmes are to be integrated and used for all health programs including vector borne disease control programs.

2.	<p>Training:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Central Leprosy Division, Directorate General of Health Services, New Delhi has given us the responsibility to conduct a condensed training program for State Leprosy Officers and District Leprosy Officers in our Institute, accordingly we have prepared a training program for 5 working days and have conducted first batch of the training program during the period from 29 November to 3 December 2010 in which 18 officers from different State viz. Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Punjab, Maharashtra, Uttar Pradesh, West Bengal have participated in the training program and as per the feedback received from the officers, they have been highly satisfied with the training program. ▪ Training has been imparted to 7 BPT students at this Institute-4 students from Medical College, Raipur and 3 students from Physiotherapy college, Raipur
