As per the information received from NVBDCP, Delhi, State Program Officer (Malaria) has been requested to send the acknowledgement of 3000 Combi Blister packs (Tab. Artesunate + Tab. Sulpha doxine pyremethamine) received from GMSD, Mumbai and 5000 Arteether Injections received from GMSD, Guwahati.2. Director of Health Services, Chhattisgarh has been requested to provide information regarding Private Sector Allopathic, Medical and Health Care Institutions and beds in Rural and Urban Areas in the States/UTs as on 31.12.2009 to CBHI, New Delhi to enable them to publish their annual publication on "National Health Profile of India".3. As desired by the NVBDCP, Delhi, State Program Officer, Malaria has been requested to submit 1st and 2nd round of spray report for the year 2010.4. Intimated Director of Health Services, Chhattisgarh about the various training programs conducted by CBHI, Delhi during the year 2011-2012.5. State Program Officer, Malaria was intimated about the Review meeting of NVBDCP activity-MDA 2010 and requested him to attend the meeting and make a brief presentation on specific issues in elimination of Lymphatic Filariasis.6. He was also requested to send the information regarding Allopathic Doctors and Dental Surgeons working in Government establishments in the State as on 31.12.2010. This information is required by CBHI, New Delhi and has to be submitted by the State latest by 15.01.2011.10. Requested State Program Officer, Malaria to depute all the newly recruited VBD consultants for three months Induction training of District VBD consultants on Malaria. As intimated by NVBDCP, Delhi, this is the last batch of training as per their contract with PHFI.11. As desired by NVBDCP, Delhi, we have requested State Program Officer, Malaria to expedite the submission of audit report for the financial year 2009-2010, Utilisation certificate and statement of expenditure upto 30.09.2010, as with out this information it is difficult for the NVBDCP to release the second installment of grant-in-aid.12.
