10	Review Of National Health Programme At District Level		Observation
10.1	NRHM	Yes	ANC, PNC, INC services are provided in all surveyed blocks. Immunization services are provided in all surveyed CHC and subcenters as per plan. Family planning services are provided in the surveyed blocks. JSY payments are given within time with good recording and reporting. EMOC services are not functioning due to non availability of the Specialist at surveyed CHC except Dongergarh Block CHC. No blood bank storage facility at surveyed CHC.RSK is constituted and utilized fund. The percentage of the achievement of Permanent methods of Family planning up to July 2010 of the district was 10%. The percentage of the achievement in IUD method was 26.1% while in OP cases more than 50% up to July 2010.
10.2	NVBDCP	Yes	The distributed RD kits utilized at CHC Microscopic center, MF register are not updated in 3 CHC. The record maintained was very poor at surveyed blocks .Delay in diagnosis more than 24 hours in all surveyed CHC and one lab of PHC. The Lab technicians were not trained in malaria diagnosis at CHC Dongergaon CHC and Somani PHC. No visible monitoring of NVBDCP from the district in surveyed blocks by the District Malaria officer. From April 2010 to July, 181538 blood slides are collected and examined, 1273 were positive for malaria of which 1201 were PV and 53 were Pf . The RD kit positive were 19.
10.3	RNTCP	Yes	The Microscopic centers were visited and assess the RNTCP indicators i.e New case microscopic detection, cure rate and sputum conversion rate. The stocks of the drugs were assessed. During current year 2481 sputum samples were taken and examined .178 persons were cured while one patient was treated as MDR TB. 25 patient were tested for HIV test none were positive.
10.4	NLEP	Yes	The DPMR activities are not recorded in all surveyed blocks except Khairagarh Block. The current prevalence rate of leprosy was 0.75. The treatment completion rate of PB cases was 75% while 100% in MB cases. RCS screening camps arranged at block level and the screening of the deformed cases at CHC.
10.5	NBCP	Yes	Annual target was 7500. 81 IOL implant in govt. setup while 2016 were in Private hospitals. The total achievement was 28.01 % during current year. Under School eye screening programme, 3726 children's were examined of which 92 were having refractory errors. Till date no spectacle were provided under this programme.
