

**ASSESSMENT OF HOME DELIVERY OF CONTRACEPTIVES PILOT PROJECT IN  
KORBA DISTRICT OF CHHATTISGARH STATE.**

(Date of Visit-16to 20 April 2012)

**ABOUT District:** Korba is often referred as the Industrial Hub of Chhattisgarh. District population as on 2011 was 1,206,563 of which male and female were 612,158 and 594,405 respectively. There was growth of 19.25 percent in the population compared to population as per 2001. Average literacy rate of Korba in 2011 were 73.22 compared to 61.71 of 2001. The district comes under Bilaspur division and is inhabited mainly by tribals including the protected tribe. Korba is blessed with lush green forest cover, where a sizeable number of tribal population is found.

The RD team visited District KORBA of the **Chhattisgarh** state for assessment of the NRHM, health facilities as per revised IPHS and cross verification of beneficiary and review of different National health programmes. The intention is to see implementation status, its progress & sustainability of pilot project in the district and identify the gaps for better implementation. The different level (from district to village level) checklists were prepared by RD Raipur based on the programme component. The team visited the randomly selected two blocks (**Kartala and Podiuproda**), two PHC namely (**Jatga and Kharwani**) and 3 HSC (**Pachara, Lainga and Sohagpur**) based on the approachability and feasibility mainly. One block is feasible and other is remote from the district headquarter Korba. There was a debriefing session of the visit with the CMO and other officials after completion of the visit. The team interacted with BMO of the concerned blocks, Medical Officers, RMA (Rural Medical Assistant) at PHCs and ANM and Male workers at HSC and ASHA workers at Village /hamlets.

***The salient observation related to Home based delivery of the contraceptives are as follows:***

- 1) The district KORBA is the one of the selected district for the pilot project of Home delivery of contraceptives (Condoms, OCPs and ECPs) by ASHA at door step of beneficiaries. The CMO and DPM are unaware of such programme and its guidelines.
- 2) At block level, BMO is unaware of such pilot project. The contraceptives are provided free of cost at HSC, PHC and CHC to the beneficiaries. There is gap in the demand and supply of contraceptives in the surveyed health institute.
- 3) At PHC level the Rural Medical Assistant/ Medical officer are unaware of such activity and these are no discussed at block meeting.
- 4) At grass root level free distribution of contraceptives continuous to exist.
- 5) The logistics concerned to the programme are yet to be received by district.
- 6) Teams has interacted with ASHA (So called mitanin in Chhattisgarh state) at Different HSC village, they are unaware of any such activities under this pilot programme.

**HSC Verification:**

- 7) Printed register available at HSC i.e Jaccha Baccha Register (State specific). ***The eligible couple register are available but no updated/ filled in surveyed HSCs.***
- 8) Out of 18 permanent sterilization clients, 11 were traced and interviewed in the field area. No fake cases on the record among traced clients. Out of total, 10 Clients were satisfied with the service provided by the health institute and staff while one client not satisfied due to sterilization failure.
- 9) **Out of 3 Subcenters 2 having no IUD user during year 2011-1210 because of no one ready to accept as told by subcenter ANM. At subcenter Sohagpur 5 IUD users were selected by team 4 were contacted and all were fake cases. All 4 beneficiaries were already undergone permanent sterilization but on record they were IUD users.**
- 10) 11 oral pills clients were selected from 3 HSCs, of which 7 were traced in field. All clients were **fake** on available record. Cause of fake reporting in the selected HSC is due to target given from blocks and they are not completed within prescribed period.
- 11) 10 condom users were selected for verification, 5 were visited in the field. **Out of five one case is genuine, while four were fake clients.**

#### Analysis of above table and Comments:

- 1) The number of Laparoscopic sterilization procedure increased at PHC level as compare to previous two year.
- 2) The OC pills were distributed during 2011-12 is 52248 among the different institutions whereas progressive stock position of the district level store shows 20,000 in last two years.
- 3) Sudden four fold increase in the OP users as compare to previous two years, which needs to be verified.
- 4) The Centchroman pills are not supplied at district but report shows 2428 were distributed needs to be verified.
- 5) The IUD users are reduced as compare to previous two years at CHC and PHC level. At district level the **user number was zero for year 2011-12.**

**Conclusion:** Initiation for implementation of the pilot project in the selected district( KORBA) of Chhattisgarh state to be taken.
