Re-sampling of 5 old cases & 2 new cases has also been taken for the study on endemicity of Leprosy and utilization of health services in selected areas of Chhattisgarh – Mahasamund district. Later on, the samples have been sent to JALMA, Agra for further molecular investigation. • Under ICMR sponsored study, a team visited the selected villages of Basna block of Mahasamund district during the period from 23-25 April 2012 and have collected 18 Slit samples, 41 soil samples, 26 water samples from patient area, common drainage and non-patient areas. It includes Re-sampling of 14 old cases & 5 sampling of new cases has been taken for the study on endemicity of Leprosy and utilization of health services in selected areas of Chhattisgarh – Mahasamund district. Later on, the samples have been sent to JALMA, Agra for further molecular investigation.

The awareness among the mother is poor related to the Colostrums, ARI, Family Planning and immunization etc in all surveyed HSCs. Out of 15, 13 mothers were satisfied with ASHA services.
