

**ASSESSMENT OF HOME DELIVERY OF CONTRACEPTIVES PILOT PROJECT IN
BILASPUR DISTRICT OF CHHATTISGARH STATE.**

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ABOUT District: As of 2011 India Census Bilaspur had a population of 26, 62,077. Males constitute 51% of the population and females 49%. Bilaspur has an average literacy rate of 72%, lower than the national average of 74%; with male literacy of 83% and female literacy of 60%. 15% of the population is under 6 years of age.

The salient observation related to Home based delivery of the contraceptives are as follows:

- 1) The district BILASPUR is the one of the selected district for the pilot project of Home delivery of contraceptives (Condoms, OCPs and ECPs) by ASHA at door step of beneficiaries. The CMO and DPM are aware of such programme and its guidelines but programme is not implemented in the blocks.
- 2) At block level, BMO is unaware of such pilot project. The contraceptives are provided free of cost at HSC, PHC and CHC to the beneficiaries. There is gap in the demand and supply of contraceptives in the surveyed health institute.
- 3) At PHC level the Rural Medical Assistant/ Medical officer are unaware of such activity and these are no discussed at block meeting.
- 4) At grass root level free distribution of contraceptives continuous to exist.
- 5) The logistics (condoms) concerned to the pilot project received by district store but none were aware of it. All condoms received under this programme were free distributed from block level due to lack of knowledge and guidelines of pilot project.

6) The record keeping of the present contraceptives stocks at block was not proper. The stock is not entered into the stock register of the Medical store and concerned health supervisor kept the stock without knowledge of the store keeper, so there are chances of misdistribution of stock. On one hand large amount of OC pill stock was supplied at PHC where utilization is poor and other hand these stock was nil at subcenter, where there is need. The stock of contraceptives is need to channelized in proper way so that it is available at each health facilities under block.

7) Teams has interacted with ASHA (So called mitanin in Chhattisgarh state) at Different HSC village, they are unaware of any such activities under this pilot programme.

HSC Verification:

- 1) Printed register available at HSC i.e Jaccha Baccha Register (State specific). **The eligible couple register are available but no updated/ filled in surveyed HSCs.**
- 2) Out of 13 permanent sterilization clients, 07 were traced and interviewed in the field area. No fake cases on the record among traced clients. All Clients were satisfied with the service provided by the health institute and staff.
- 3) 11 IUD users were selected; out of them 2 were fake cases on record. HMIS report having more number of clients.
- 4) **8** oral pills clients were selected from 3 HSCs, of which 5 were traced in field. All clients were **fake** on available record. Cause of fake reporting in the selected HSC is due to target given from blocks and they are not completed within prescribed period. HMIS reports were also showing series of numbers from APRIL 2011 to March 2012. All cases were not listed and fake reported to HMIS. At AMADHA and PODIKALA subcenter, OC pill stock is not provided since last Oct 2011.
- 5) **8** condom users were selected for verification, 5 were visited in the field. **Out of five, two cases is genuine, while three were fake clients.** At AMADHA and PODIKALA subcenter, condom stock is not provided since last Oct 2011. All cases reported to HMIS report are faked.

Stock of Contraceptives:

Record of Contraceptives at Kota CHC are not update, many entries are not done in the stock registers, which was kept by supervisor.

Inference: A reported figure is exorbitant high than supplied items indicating false reporting or inadventely data.

Conclusion: Initiation for implementation of the pilot project in the selected district (BILASPUR) of Chhattisgarh state to be taken.
