

## **OBSERVATIONS OF SURVEYED HEALTH FACILITY for NPPCDCS**

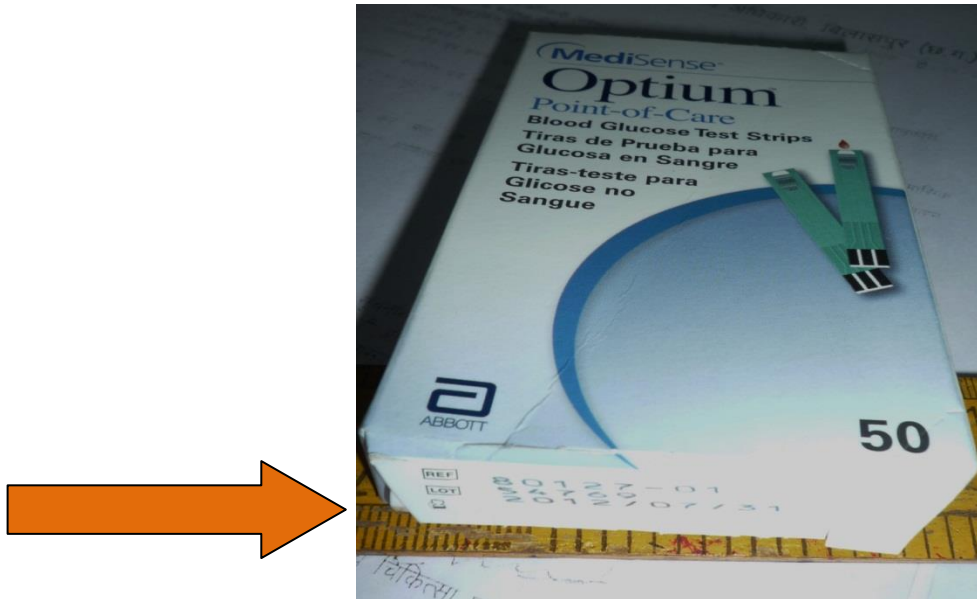
### **1) Programme Human Resource**

**District:** Dr Jeevani is programme officer of NCD. Till date contractual staff is not appointed at District as well as blocks.

**Block:** The programme and its implementation details of NCD programme were not available.

**2) Training:** Glucometer was provided to district level. The district authorities imparted training of limited sector workers in each block and distributed glucometer and strips along with them. There is also need further training of 384 HSC staff of the district.

**3) Logistics:** 80,000 glucostrips received to district had short expiry date. To avoid expiry of strips, they have organized 717 camps in 9 blocks and screened 78345 peoples from Oct 2011 to Feb 2012. 1887 diabetics' patients were suspected and 604 hypertensive during field campaign. During RD visit to Kota, Pendra and Thakatpur the team has not found the present treatment status of referred patients.

The district programme authority unaware of delivery the second lot of strips. The lot assignment was kept in the district store from Nov 2011 to May 2012 so that there was delay in the distribution. There is need for further streamline the stock from state store, district to peripheral health institute.

**Diagnosis and referral in place:** The team has visited the three blocks, 3 primary centres and three health subcenter.

It's important after organizing camps to referral and start the appropriate management at nearest health facility but the referral is very less to CHC, Most of the patients are in community yet to receive treatment. The consumption pattern of antihypertensive and diabetics stock at CHC store after organizing camp has not significantly change as expected. Hence there is need to create more awareness of the programme in the community and in local leaders regarding availability of services at block level.
