

**ASSESSMENT OF HOME DELIVERY OF CONTRACEPTIVES PILOT PROJECT IN
KONDAGAON DISTRICT (Bastar Region) OF CHHATTISGARH STATE.**

(Date of Visit- 13 to 7th MAY 2012)

ABOUT District: Kondagaon is a district separated from bastar district on 24 January 2012 and formed as 27th district of Chhattisgarh state a municipality in the Indian state. This is a tribal district. Thus the culture and the customs are different here from the other parts of the state. of Chhattisgarh. The Undivided Bastar is selected district under home delivery of contraceptive pilot project.

The salient observation related to Home based delivery of the contraceptives are as follows:

- 1) The district Bastar is the one of the selected district for the pilot project of Home delivery of contraceptives (Condoms, OCPs and ECPs) by ASHA at door step of beneficiaries. It was a part of the **Bastar district** of the state. The CMO and DPM is unaware of such programme.
- 2) At surveyed blocks, BMO, BE, BPM and Supervisors were unaware of such pilot project. The contraceptives are provided free of cost at HSC, PHC and CHC to the beneficiaries. Among the Bagchiya Block medical officer and health supervisor at District, there was confusion about user charges (Rs1, Rs2 and Rs3) and who too paid. The team has provided the guidelines regarding the programme.
- 3) At PHC level the Rural Medical Assistant/ Medical officer are unaware of such activity and these are no discussed at block meeting.
- 4) At grass root level free distribution of contraceptives continuous to exist.
- 5) The logistics (condoms) concerned to the pilot project received by district store from bastar district but none were aware of it for its implementation. All condoms and OC pills received under this programme were free distributed from block level due to lack of initiatives.

- 6) The record keeping of the present contraceptives stocks at block was not proper maintained at all selected blocks. The stock is not enters into the stock register of the Medical store and distributed to sectors equally.
- 7) Teams has interacted with ASHA (So called mitanin in Chhattisgarh state) at Different HSC village, they are unaware of any such activities under this pilot programme.

HSC Verification:

- 1) Printed register available at HSC i.e Jaccha Baccha Register (State specific). *The eligible couple register are available at all surveyed HSC but not propely upadted.*
- 2) Out of 20 permanent sterilization clients, 12 were traced and interviewed in the field area. No fake cases on the record among traced clients. Two male clients were found failure after permanent sterilization.They are not aware of the compensation of failure.
- 3) **20 oral** pills clients were selected from 4 HSCs, of which 9 were traced in field. 4 clients were **fake** on available record. Cause of fake reporting in the selected HSC is due to target given from blocks and they are not completed within prescribed period. HMIS reports were also showing series of numbers from APRIL 2012 to March 2013. All cases were not listed and fake reported to HMIS.
- 4) 20 IUD users were contacted out of 14 selected. 10 clients were fake cases on record. HMIS report having more number of clients.
- 5) 21 condom users were selected for verification, 10 were visited in the field. **Out of visited clients, six were fake clients.** All cases reported to HIMS are fake.
- 6) The stock of Copper T and Oc Pills are exhausted at Tortanga HSC and overstock of pills and IUD noted at Nayanar during survey.

Conclusion: Initiation for implementation of the pilot project in the selected area of **Bastar** (Kondagaon) of Chhattisgarh state to be taken.
